


OUR RESPONSE TO COVID-19

Public examinations were cancelled for the second year running as part of the UK's response to the COVID-19 pandemic. In their place, students received grades awarded and determined by teachers based on the content they had been taught. These were known as teacher assessed grades or TAGs. Teachers drew on a range of evidence when determining the TAGs, including the use of questions provided by exam boards under high control conditions, as well as mock exams, coursework, and other work completed as part of a student's course, such as essays and in-class tests. Our students were fortunate in so far as they were able to attend school in person for almost the whole of the academic year without any interruption to teaching. Consequently, they leave Dubai College with greater knowledge, skills and understanding than many of their peers in other schools in the UK and overseas and the TAGs they were awarded reflect this.




ACCREDITATION
